



## Errata for 1.0

Though great care was taken to ensure that the rules were as bug free as possible, there remained some typos in the final print-out. Those found so far constitute the following list:

### Page 5; 4.2; Range marks table; last entry

Delete ; **Rockets**.

### Page 11; 9.4; 2<sup>nd</sup> para; line 3; word 7

Remove **more**, insert **increased by**.

### Page 15; 12.7; ‘\*’ call in the bottom; 1<sup>st</sup> para; word 11

Remove **Land**, insert **Lend**.

### Page 19; 15.3; 3<sup>rd</sup> para; line 1; word 7

Remove **heavier**, insert **lighter**.

### Page 27; Reinforcements; 6<sup>th</sup> para; line 1; word 22

Replace Panzer II **F**; by Panzer II **A-C**. Note: in fact the Panzer II b or c could also have been used.

### Page 41; Poland data chart; 2<sup>nd</sup> entry

Vickers 6-T E: 1/1 F/R; add **LS** to CH.

### Page 42; USA data chart; 1<sup>st</sup> para (under the main header)

Delete **AP**. “CH” afterwards is correct

Stuart M3A1/M5/M5A1: **LF** must be added to the CH column.

Sherman M4A3w 76: delete **uv1** in the PN column; insert **11**. Note: it is assumed that a small quantity of the improved ammo supplied to the tank destroyer units by 44/11 would have reached the US spearhead tank units.

### Page 44; France data chart; 4<sup>th</sup> entry

Hotchkiss H39 (APX-R1): **4/3** missing in the F/R column; **2/tk** missing in MV; add ;**LF** to CH column.
